**The Position.** The Vice President of Economic Development is responsible for leading a focused effort to increase the local tax base and grow new, high-quality jobs in Carroll County. This includes the expansion and retention of existing businesses.

The professional leader is accountable for both commercial and industrial recruitment. Other responsibilities include: property data base maintenance; project lead development; site visits; providing leadership and guidance to development authorities; oversight of all daily operations and budgets; and, in collaboration with developing the community, implementing economic development an strategic plan.

The Vice President represents Carroll Tomorrow at meetings with clients, investors, developers, community leaders, and other stakeholders.

**Qualifications.** Candidates applying for the economic development position should hold a Bachelor's degree, ideally with an MBA or other post-graduate work, from an accredited college.
