

## City of Chamblee Selects Wylly Harrison as New Economic Development Director

He will also be accountable for leading, directing, and facilitating inclusive and strategic economic development initiatives to grow and maintain jobs and increase the business tax base for the city, including commercial and industrial recruitment and support services for existing businesses.

The director also acts as a staff liaison and Executive Director for the Chamblee Downtown Development Authority (CDDA).
